You may send in your application at any time; however, we will not begin processing applications until January.

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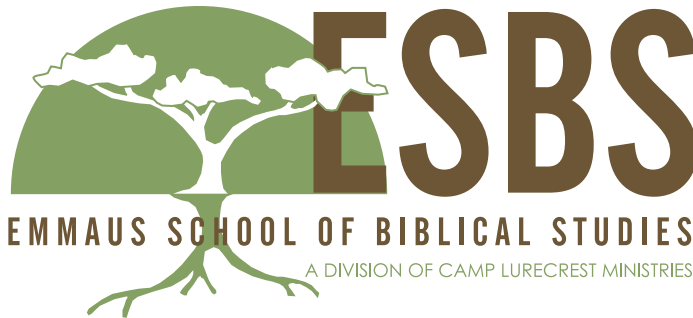
